- Offertory Prayer Ministry

  - Greet visitors and regulars as they arrive for morning worship
  - Distribute worship materials to people as they arrive
  - Assist newcomers with directions within the church
  - Be friendly, welcoming, and helpful
  - Collect the offering during service
  - Take the initiative in emergency situations
- Outreach Ministry
  - Write and mail cards to visitors, absentees, those going through hard times, etc
  - Make phone calls to visitors, absentees, those going through hard times, etc
  - Make home visits to visitors, absentees, those going through hard times, etc
  - Plan and carry out events at the church that will bring in visitors
