Commission decided to consolidate in First Methodist's Restore building. I requested an audience with the commission and drove to Columbiana to explain why we thought this was a great community service and wished the council to reconsider. Our commissioner agreed, but the majority said they'd have to support the recommendation as a cost-saving measure (though we never received money).

Our building use policy states that our property is available for members without charge, but extraordinary requests require church approval. We used to get a lot of requests for children's birthday parties and the like, and would explain we don't have staffing nor custodial scheduling to do this. Plus our building is now very "open" and there's no good way to block off areas where these groups shouldn't be. Our policy has worked out very well since our members always leave things better and cleaner than they found them.


